We ask parents to collect and drop off swiftly to avoid congestion. Parents will be able to drop and collect from designated areas in the playground. On site parent meetings with staff will be by invitation only.

Tuesday 3rd September

All children return to school. The school day starts at **9.00am** please arrive 5-10 minutes beforehand and school will finish at **3.20pm**.

Vertical grouping

This academic year we successfully vertically grouped year 1 and year 2 children. This means that both year groups were taught in the same class together. Our teachers are highly skilled and are able to plan effectively to meet the needs and abilities of all the children in the class. This year we are extending this arrangement to year 3 and 4. Please be assured this has no reflection on your child's ability and is just a way that many schools choose to group their children to learn as two-year groups and within mixed ability classes.

Lunch and Play Times

All breaks will be staggered by Phase and children will be allocated areas of the playground to play. Cont...





Uniform

All children are to wear full school uniform every day, as well as wearing PE kit during physical education lessons.

School dinners

Hot lunches will be available and all children can have a free hot meal. Please sign up for free school meals if your child is entitled to them. <u>https://lewisham.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals</u>. This provides additional funding for the school and access to holiday meal vouchers while that government scheme is running.

Communicating with the class teacher

Parents may not always be able to speak to the class teacher after school or in the morning. Instead, parents are able to email the class teacher using the class email address. <u>classname@deptfordpark.org</u> for example: <u>pearl@deptfordpark.org</u>. Teachers will respond within 48 hours during term time working days. More urgent requests should go to the office via an email or phone call.

Home Learning

The majority of homework will be delivered via Google classroom.

Breakfast and after school clubs

Breakfast and after school club will start on Tuesday 5th September.

Extra-curricular Clubs

Extra-curricular Clubs will run in the first-half of the Autumn Term and will begin week commencing 16th September 2024. Places will be allocated in the first fortnight.

Attendance

All children are expected to attend school regularly and maintain an attendance of 96% or above in line with Government guidelines. Absenteeism will be monitored and parents will be required to explain every absence period promptly.

Lost Property

Lost property will be displayed in the playground after school this week on Monday 22nd and Tuesday 23rd July. Any items not claimed will be donated.
