



Dear Parents and Carers,

This is a summary of the topics we will be covering this term in Year 6.

Project: Emotional Literacy English: Diary, Flashback, Persuasion/Argument, Poetry, Report, Character/Settings and Plot, SPAG and Spelling. Maths: Place Value, Four Operations, Problem Solving, Fractions, Reasoning. Science: Light, Electricity. Computing: Computing Systems and Networks. History: Vikings. Art/DT: Drawing and Sketching. RE: Journey of Life and Death, Judaism (Abraham). French: Actions, In France. Music: Rounds and Sound Sources. PSHE: Learning, Emotional Management. PE: Basketball, Hockey.

Homework.

As well as weekly homework to complete on Google Classroom, the tasks below need to be completed. Maths, Reading and Spellings must be the focus.

Maths: Revise and practice multiplication tables as well as related division facts.

E.g. $4 \times 7 = 28$, $7 \times 4 = 28$, $28 \div 4 = 7$ and $28 \div 7 = 4$

Extend this to include ideas such as $2800 \div 70 = 40$ or $\pounds 0.70 \times 4 = \pounds 2.80$ for example.

Mathletics has many skills and activities to aid your child with their mathematics as well.

Reading: Reading should be done for at least **15-20 minutes every night** (around 10 pages) and your child then needs to complete their **Reading Record**. They must include the pages they read and a thoughtful comment about what they have read. They can include recommendations, summaries, new vocabulary, character analysis, predictions etc.

BugClub is an online reading tool where skill appropriate books and questions are available for your child.

Spellings: Attached are the Year 3 and 4 spelling list and the Year 5 and 6 spelling list. Your child must know how to spell these words by the end of KS2, so practice two or three a night and they will become much more confident when it comes to SATs week. There is a checklist in the back of the **Reading Record** for the Y5/6 spellings.

SAT'S Companion: Revision and tasks will be set for your child to complete. SAT's Companion is an all-in-one tool for targeted practice in Maths, Reading, Spelling, Grammar & Punctuation, and Science.

Charanga (Yumu): Every half term, there will be a music homework set for your child to try. They will be guided by the online instructions which are clear for them to follow.
