Worried about your loved one losing the Winter Fuel Payment?

Pensioners will no longer automatically receive the Winter Fuel Payment unless they claim Pension Credit. Pension Credit is worth an average £3,900 per year and it's also a gateway to other benefits including housing support, Council Tax discounts and the Winter Fuel Payment itself. Millions of pounds goes unclaimed in Lewisham every year so if you think you – or someone you know – might be eligible, [please visit BetterOff Lewisham](#). **Apply before Saturday 21 December, to make a backdated claim and receive the Winter Fuel Payment this winter.**
